The permission/permit granted on 2012-09-28 to host the “#Moonlightmass” event with the following details refers:

Date/s: 30 September, 29 October, 28 November, 28 December 2012
Time: 21h00 – 22h30
Venue/Route: Green Point Stadium Precinct to Green Market Square, Cape Town

The Municipality of the City of Cape Town granted permission subject to compliance with, inter alia, the following conditions:

- I. Immediate Emergency Vehicular access and egress to be guaranteed at all times;
- II. Notwithstanding the deployment of the Traffic Officers, the Event Organiser will ensure sufficient marshals are deployed along the route to ensure the safety of participants and spectators.
- III. The instructions of all Law Enforcement, Disaster Management, Fire and Safety and Medical personnel are to be obeyed at all times.
- IV. All traffic laws to be obeyed.
- V. Pedestrian and vehicular traffic must not be unduly disrupted.
- VI. All instructions by duly authorized officials must be obeyed at all times.
- VII. While permission is issued for the abovementioned dates, the City reserves the right to, at its sole discretion, revoke such permission should a review of the event by City Services and/or SAPS reveal that the conditions attached hereto have not been satisfactorily complied with, or that such action would be in the interests of public safety.

Subsequent to the hosting of the event on various of the dates listed above concerns regarding issues of public safety have been reported to the City’s Event Co-ordination Committee by various city service departments.

In an effort to address the concerns and to ensure the safety of the public and participants during the hosting of the event, the Events Permit Office has on several occasions requested you, as the event organiser, to meet with the Event Co-ordination Committee to address the concerns associated with the hosting of the event. These requests have been ignored and this has led to city services informing

the Committee that, pending the resolution of the public safety concerns, they would no longer support the hosting of the event.

Accordingly, the Event Permit for the hosting of the #Moonlightmass event has been withdrawn forthwith, pending the Event Organiser meeting with the city's Event Co-ordination Committee and the resolution of the public safety concerns associated with the event.

We look forward to meeting with you forthwith.
